Lessons 1–7

These vocabulary cards for the Chuvash language are based on the textbook *Чувашский язык: Начальный курс*, И.А. Андреев (Чебоксары: Чувашское книжное издательство, 1996). Andreev's textbook doesn't give simple lists of new vocabulary in each chapter, expecting the student intend to memorize the words he must look up in the dictionary in order to understand the reading material. I have tried to guess which words are considered essential for each chapter.

These cards do not contain all possible vocabulary. I have omitted words which the student can understand based on previous items. For example, flashcards are provided for the numbers one through ten, but not for the teens, as the latter are based regularly on the former. Along the same lines I have left out oblique cases of nouns and pronouns, expecting that the student will memorize them from declensional paradigms.

The cards should be printed double-sided on card stock. One may use Avery 5371 paper,¹ which has perforations for the cards, to avoid the trouble of cutting them oneself.

The set was typeset with the L^AT_EX 2_ε typesetting system with the document class `flashcards` and Chuvash represented in the X2 font encoding for Cyrillic.
